

Application Video Guide for the Teach & Learn in Spain Program

For this year's application cycle, applicants **must submit a video introduction** in lieu of the traditional graduate interview and statement of purpose. Your recording does not need to be extensively rehearsed or polished, and the video does not need to be edited. Envision this video as if it were a statement of purpose.

You may record your video introduction using the platform of your choice (Vimeo, QuickTime Player, smartphone, etc.). Then send the introduction video to Wetransfer.com (https://wetransfer.com/) to admissions@institutofranklin.net. The file should be named "LastName, FirstName Video" (ex: Smith, Jessica Video). Be sure to name your video "LastName, FirstName Video" so that we know it's from you! Your video should be no longer than three (3) minutes in length and have a maximum file size of 2GB. You will receive an email from WeTransfer once we have downloaded your file.

If there is any important information relevant to your candidacy you were unable to address elsewhere in the application, please share that information in this video. Envision this video as your statement of purpose for acceptance into the program.

Your video should address the following:

- 1. An introduction of yourself
- 2. Identify the Master's degree to which you are applying.
- 3. Briefly state your reasons for applying to the program
- 4. Describe your experience working with children.
- 5. Answer the following: Why do you want to expand your teaching experience by being a language assistant in a Spanish bilingual school, and what do you believe you will gain from the experience?

Please speak slowly and clearly, and be sure to keep your video professional. Upon acceptance to the program, these videos are shared with our partner schools and are used to help in the selection and school assignment process.

In addition, our admissions team may contact you to request a virtual interview to supplement your application. Candidates who are not offered an interview are not at any disadvantage in the admissions process.
